PAVEMENT RESURFACING PROMPTS LANE/RAMP CLOSURES **25 MILES OF STATE ROUTE 58 FROM MOJAVE TO BORON**

WHO: The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with Maverick Asphalt and Construction Company will begin a pavement rehabilitation project.

WHAT: The approximately \$3-million project will rehabilitate the pavement and ramps on State Route 58.

WHERE: A 25-mile segment of State Route 58 from 1.1 mile east of the Business Route 58 overcrossing near Mojave to the San Bernardino County Line near Boron.

WHEN: Work begins Monday, May 4, 2009. Work hours: Mondays through Thursdays from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Fridays from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m. The project is expected to be complete in early summer.

Week of May 4 – 8, 2009: Removal of permanent lane and ramp striping throughout the 25-mile project limits. Temporary lane and ramp markers will be installed during construction. (Work schedule subject to weather and equipment reliability)

DETOUR: Freeway lane and ramp closures will occur throughout the duration of the project. Motorists will be alerted via construction signage and electronic message boards along SR-58 and near affected lane closures and freeway interchanges.

Caltrans thanks motorists for their patience as we rehabilitate this segment of SR-58. Motorists are reminded to allow additional travel time and drive with extra care through construction zones. Please "Slow for the Cone Zone."
