BE WORK ZONE ALERT!

EXPECT INCREASED DELAYS ON STATE ROUTE 138 HORSETHIEF CREEK BRIDGE

HESPERIA – On Thursday, April 30, 2015 between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. motorists can expect intermittent, 20 minute traffic, delays at Horsethief Creek Bridge near Hesperia, California on State Route 138 (SR-138). Flaggers will be on either side of the bridge to direct traffic.

The traffic breaks will allow construction crews to safely unload and hoist six (6) precast girders across the bridge and put into place. Motorists should expect delays and add time to your commute.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is replacing the SR-138 Horsethief Creek Bridge in Hesperia, CA. The new bridge, estimated at \$5.8 million, will be designed to resist local environmental conditions. The two-lane undivided conventional highway serves the communities of Crestline, Summit Valley and Silverwood Lake.

Caltrans asks that motorists please be aware of the work and SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE.
