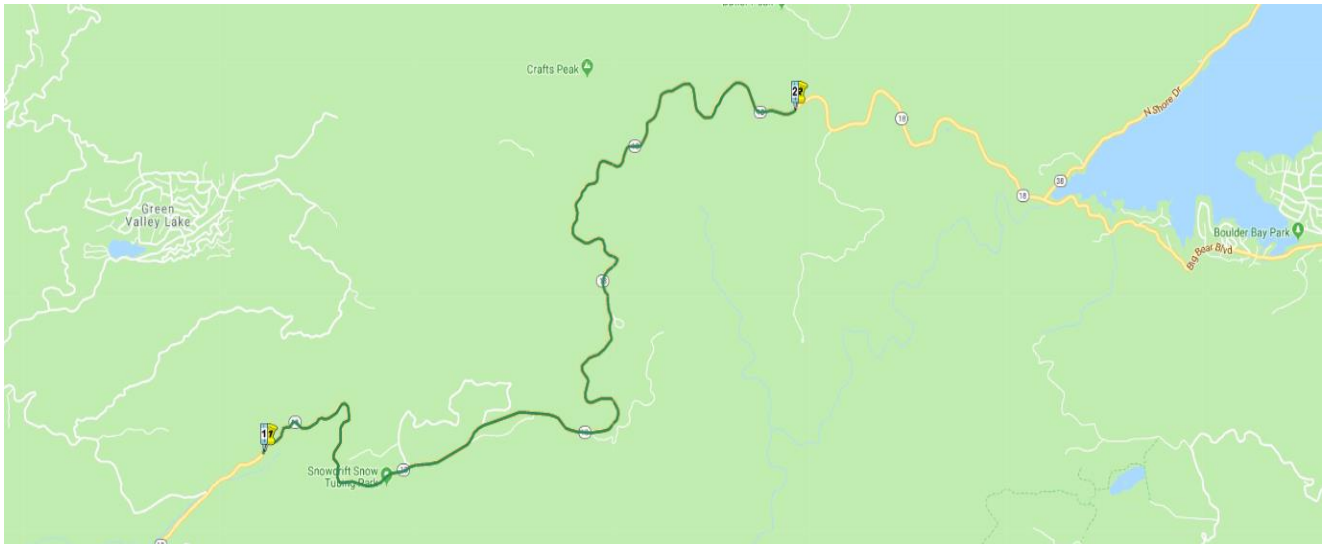

## EMERGENCY ROAD REPAIR WORK ON STATE ROUTE 18

**SAN BERNARDINO** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will start the next phase of emergency drainage, guardrail and slope repairs on State Route 18 (SR-18) south of Green Valley Lake Rd. (PM 35) until north of Glory Ridge Rd. (PM 42) near Big Bear. Work will begin Monday, May 13 and last approximately two months. Traffic will be controlled by a flagging operation at various locations Monday through Friday, 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. and occasionally on Saturdays from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m.
