PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT BEGINS ON INTERSTATE 10 FROM THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY LINE TO MILLIKEN AVENUE IN ONTARIO

San Bernardino – Construction begins this week on a slab replacement project which will provide pavement rehabilitation on Interstate 10 (I-10) from the Los Angeles County line to Milliken Avenue in the City of Ontario. This \$3.3 million project will improve the ride quality, extend pavement life and improve facility operation and safety.

The work will begin on Monday, May 7 and all work will be conducted from 10:00 p.m. through 5:00 a.m. The work will take place in sections along the I-10 and will move as each section is completed. There will be alternating lane closures in *these sections* with up to three lanes closed at a time in order to insure safe working and driving conditions. A minimum of one lane will be open at all time.
