WHAT: FULL CLOSURE & FLAGGING

WHEN: MAY 11 TO 15, 2009

WHERE: STATE ROUTE 330

San Bernardino Mountains - Caltrans will save you some time and inconvenience for routine maintenance on State Route 330 (SR-330) this year. Instead of flagging for two to three weeks on the route for guardrail repair and routine maintenance, there will be a mid-week full closure of SR-330 on Wednesday and Thursday, May 13 and 14, from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. **There will also be flagging during those hours on Monday, Tuesday and Friday (May 11, 12, and 15) due to the high amount of guardrail repair to complete.** This will allow safe access to the crews to complete yearly maintenance work and give the mountain drivers a break from weeks of flagging and delays.

Maintenance crews will perform guardrail replacement and repair, drain cleaning, shoulder work, sign replacement, and other necessary work.

Guardrail repair will move to State Route 18 (SR-18) the following week (May 18) from 48th Street to SR-138 (Crestline Cutoff). More information will be released on this work by Friday, May 8.

Caltrans is asking for the public's cooperation while we expedite the work. Motorists are advised to plan their commute ahead of time and possibly adjust their schedule for those two days to avoid the closure. SR-18 will be available along with SR-38 as alternate routes.
