**UPDATE- STATE ROUTE 111 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT**

**SAN BERNARDINO** – The California Department of Transportation and All American Asphalt continue work on the \$1.53 million project to rehabilitate State Route 111 (SR-111) between the Palm Springs International Airport and Gateway Drive. Below is next week’s schedule of operations. This schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or construction needs.

DATE	OPERATIONS	LOCATION	HOURS
Week of May 9 <sup>th</sup>	Slurry Seal	Northbound from District Center on Gene Autry Trail, then west on Vista Chino	7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

The contractor will slurry seal one mile segments at a time, working across multiple lanes of SR- 111 (both directions). Traffic patterns will be altered and traffic control will be in effect throughout the construction zone. Please SLOW DOWN and follow the instructions given by the construction personnel.

Driveways will be temporarily blocked during the slurry seal operation. Vehicles will not be permitted to drive across the hot slurry as it requires four hours to cure. The contractor has placed notices on local driveways advising that the project is approaching. Plan ahead and make alternate parking arrangements. Avoid delays by choosing another route.

Thank you for your patience as Caltrans works to improve SR-111.
