



SR-74 Safety Improvement Project Traffic Advisory

Ortega Highway to Remain Open at Night May 9 and 10, 2008

WHAT: The full nightly closure on SR-74 (Ortega Highway) will be lifted on May 9 and May 10, 2008 to serve as an alternate route for the full freeway construction closure of State Route 91 (Riverside Freeway) at Green River Road in the city of Corona. During this time, continuous flagging operations will be in effect through the current SR-74 Safety Improvement Project area. The road in the project area will be down to one lane, approximately one mile west of the Riverside/Orange County line.

With safety as Caltrans number one priority, Caltrans asks that motorists be mindful of the construction equipment and crews, and to follow the decreased traffic speeds posted through the project area. Fines are doubled in the construction zone and being strictly enforced.

WHEN: *Friday, May 9 and Saturday, May 10 at 8:30 p.m.* There will be continuous flagging in place at night with one lane open in the construction zone. Full night closures will resume daily on Sunday, May 11 from 8:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m.

WHERE: Approximately one mile west of the Riverside/Orange County line
