State Route 111 (SR-111) Salton Sea Creek Bridge Project

Crews are working to replace the Salton Sea Creek Bridge on SR-111 south of Indio. The existing bridge has 11-foot lanes and one foot shoulders, so a new bridge is needed to meet the standard geometric requirements and enhance the safety of the public.

In order to allow workers to perform the work safely k-rail needs to be installed. The k-rail installation will take place on May 14, 2014 and will reduce SR-111 to one lane of eleven feet, nine inches. Reversible traffic control with flaggers will be in effect in install the k-rail, as well as while SR-111 is reduced (until March 2015) from Salt Creek Campground Road to Ash Ditch.
