NOTICE OF TRAVEL DELAYS

DATE: 21 May 2010

DISTRICT: 8 - INLAND EMPIRE

WHO: 2010 Amgen Tour of California

WHEN: Friday, May 21 from 12:30 pm to 3:30 pm

WHERE: **Hwy 2** between Big Pine and Sheep Canyon Rd. Westbound traffic will experience delays up to 30 minutes. The **Hwy 138** ramps at I-15 will be temporarily closed for 30 minutes sometime between 12:30pm and 1:45pm. As soon as the race clears I-15, the ramps will immediately re-open to normal traffic. **Hwy 138** between Lone Pine Canyon and Hwy 18. Westbound traffic will experience delays up to 45 minutes. **Hwy 18** from Hwy 138 to the Big Bear Lake Dam. Southbound traffic could experience delays up to 60 minutes. **Hwy 38** from the Big Bear Lake dam to the Stanfield Cutoff. Westbound traffic could experience delays up to 30 minutes. **Hwy 18** at Summit Ave in Big Bear Lake will experience intermittent delays starting at 2:30pm until 4:00pm.

Traffic will be allowed to cross the race route, at the discretion of CHP

This is a rolling closure event. The roads will close as the race approaches and will reopen as the race passes any given point on the course. Traffic may follow behind the race. It should take the race no longer than 35 minutes to pass any intersection along the route.

WHY: For eight days in May, California will again be the backdrop of what promises to be one of the most exciting sporting events in the world of professional bicycle racing. Lance Armstrong and the 2010 Amgen Tour of California will race from Nevada City to the Conjeo Valley from May 16th to May 23rd. Stage 6 from Palmdale to Big Bear Lake, will take place on May 21st.
