



# INTERSTATE 215 SOUTH WIDENING PROJECT CONSTRUCTION ALERT

**Alert #6**

**Date: May 11, 2011**

**MURRIETA** – The Riverside County Transportation Commission, the California Department of Transportation and the City of Murrieta are working to widen Interstate 215 between Murrieta Hot Springs Road and Scott Road.

Construction crews have completed drainage work along the freeway planned for this week. Previously scheduled lane closures for the remainder of this week have been cancelled.

Closures cancelled as follows:

<b>CANCELLED</b>  Alternating Freeway Lane Closures	Southbound I-215 between Murrieta Hot Springs Road and Scott Road	<b>Wed., and Thurs., May 11 and 12</b> Lane closures will occur from 9 pm to 5 am the following morning. <b>Fri., May 13</b> Lane closure will occur from 10 pm to 6 am the following morning. No detour will be required since at least one travel lane will remain open.
<b>CANCELLED</b>  Alternating Freeway Lane Closures	Northbound I-215 between Murrieta Hot Springs Road and Scott Road	<b>Wed., and Thurs., May 11 and 12</b> Lane closures will occur from 10 pm to 6 am the following morning. <b>Fri., May 13</b> Lane closure will occur from 11 pm to 7 am the following morning. No detour will be required since at least one travel lane will remain open.

The project will add one lane in each direction to Interstate 215, creating three northbound lanes and three southbound lanes within this six-mile section of freeway. When completed, the project will reduce traffic congestion and delays, improve connections between Riverside and San Diego Counties, enhance goods movement and decrease air pollution from cars that now sit idle on the freeway.

Construction is expected to last about 16 months. Throughout construction, remember to **Slow for the Cone Zone!**
