STATE ROUTE 18 PROJECT IN BIG BEAR CITY

SCHEDULE REVISION

BIG BEAR CITY—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin work next week on a safety project on State Route 18 (SR-18) at Big Tree Drive in Big Bear City. This \$469,000 project, awarded to Dreambuilders of Placentia, will widen the roadway, plus re-stripe the intersection to provide one through-lane and a left-turn lane for both directions. With the recent increase in traffic on SR-18, these improvements will enhance safety at this location.

Crews will perform the majority of the work during nighttime hours. There will be flagging traffic control as noted. Daytime work may also occur with shoulder closures, if needed. The project is expected to be completed by the end of May 2014 (weather permitting). The work schedule will take place as follows below:
