



I-215 WIDENING PROJECT

Traffic Shift and Ramp Closure/Opening Notification

Beginning May 23, 2011



As part of the Interstate 215 Widening Project, NB and SB I-215 will undergo changes to allow construction crews to continue work through the corridor. The information included below details a planned traffic shift in both the NB and SB directions and three ramp openings or closures. As a reminder, please drive at safe speeds and leave appropriate braking distances while traveling through the corridor.

Traffic Shift

NB I-215 near I-215/SR-259 split: Temporary slight shift farther east scheduled to begin Monday, May 23 at 6 a.m.

SB I-215 near I-215/SR-259 merge: Temporary lowering of SB traffic elevation by approximately 20 feet scheduled to begin Thursday, May 26 at 5 a.m.

Ramp Opening

SB I-215 5th Street Off-Ramp: Scheduled to open Friday, May 27 at 5 a.m.

Ramps Closing

SB I-215 3rd Street Off-Ramp: Scheduled to close Tuesday, May 31 at 9 a.m. for approximately eight months to allow construction crews to continue work on the SB I-215 5th Street on-ramp.

Detour: To Downtown San Bernardino, drivers may exit I-215 at 5th Street and turn left to travel east. Drivers traveling west on 3rd Street will be detoured from 5th Street to G Street to 3rd Street.

SB I-215 27th Street Off-Ramp: Scheduled to close Wednesday, June 1 at 6 a.m. for approximately one year to allow construction crews to complete the new 27th Street off-ramp.

Detour: Drivers may take WB SR-210, exit State Street and turn right, turn right on Highland Avenue and head east to access Mt. Vernon Avenue/27th Street.
