COMMUTER ALERT 91 HOV PROJECT UPDATE

Riverside – Caltrans continues construction on the new six-mile long High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) project on State Route 91 (SR91) through downtown Riverside. Pile driving will begin this week at the Pachappa Rail Bridge in order to prepare for the construction of the new railroad bridge.

Beginning Wednesday, May 29, the contractor will begin pile driving at the Pachappa railroad bridge on SR 91. This pile driving will take place from 7AM- 10PM, Monday through Friday, and will last approximately three weeks. No lane closures will be required for this work, but please drive carefully through the construction zone for the safety of all.

Allow extra commute time as delays are expected. Follow the instructions on advisory signs within the project limits. Please drive courteously and merge early. Thank you for your patience.
