**TRAFFIC ADVISORY: I-10 / RIVERSIDE AVENUE INTERCHANGE PROJECT**

**Rialto, CA** – SANBAG, the City of Rialto and Caltrans are working to replace the Interstate 10/Riverside Avenue interchange in Rialto. The project includes replacing the existing five-lane Riverside Avenue bridge over I-10 with a nine-lane bridge.

A full closure of the Riverside Avenue bridge over Interstate 10 began in late April and is expected to continue for approximately 7 months. All freeway on-ramps and off-ramps will remain in operation during the bridge closure; however, occasional ramp closures may be required.
