In the interest of safety, **attendants will be required to wear pants and thick-soled, covered shoes** to be allowed on the construction site. Individuals not adhering to the dress policy will be denied access to the tour. Construction safety equipment and training will be provided for all attending individuals at the meeting point.

All interested parties are welcome to come; however, **those under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.**

After all individuals have been checked to be in compliance with safety regulations, a few dedicated and knowledgeable members of our team will guide guests through the construction site to a safe zone from which all guests can watch the bridge demolition.


Reservations
