STATE ROUTE 2 REOPENS THIS FRIDAY!

San Bernardino County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is pleased to announce that State Route 2 (SR-2) from Vincent’s Gap to Islip Saddle will reopen on Friday, June 3, at approximately 12:00 p.m. The route will also reopen on the Los Angeles County side at the same time.

This 10-mile segment of SR-2 just west of Wrightwood closes annually during snow season due to high snow drifts and unmanageable conditions. Damage was incurred this winter on the Los Angeles County section west of Islip Saddle, however, repairs will be made with flagging rather than keeping the route closed into the summer months.

The route will close again for a 24-hour period to allow a maintenance project to fog seal the section between Vincents Gap and Islip Saddle (west of Wrightwood) from June 9 at 7:00 a.m. to June 10 at 7:00 a.m.

This scenic route provides a direct connection to and from Los Angeles and San Bernardino County for motorists, sports enthusiasts, and emergency responders. The breathtaking scenery and relaxing drive are always a summer tourist destination.
