STATE ROUTE 74 PAVEMENT PRESERVATION PROJECT NEAR PERRIS

RIVERSIDE – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin a pavement preservation project on State Route 74 (SR 74) through the communities of Romoland and Homeland beginning the week of June 6, 2016. The project will apply a slurry seal to approximately five miles of SR 74 in both directions from Interstate 215 (I-215) to Guthridge Lane.

The \$800,000 contract was awarded to VSS International, Inc. The contractor will install construction area signs next week and begin work the week of June 13. The work hours are Monday through Friday from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. with one lane closed in each direction. One lane in each direction will remain open on the four lane highway during work hours.

The project is expected to be completed in fall 2016, weather permitting. Motorists are advised to add time to their commute to allow for minimal delays or use alternate routes to avoid the work.
