### **COMMUNITY INFORMATION MEETING FOR STATE ROUTE 74 RAISED CURB MEDIAN PROJECT IN HEMET**

**RIVERSIDE** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will host a community information meeting for the upcoming State Route 74 (SR 74) Raised Curb Median Project in Hemet which is expected to begin in 2018. The \$7.3 million project will construct a raised curb median with access points and left turn lanes at various locations from just west of Acacia Avenue to Ramona Expressway. The project is expected to last approximately one year.

Caltrans is working with the City of Hemet and will gather input from the community, business owners, emergency responders, medical facilities, and other agencies to assist with the design of the raised curb median project.
