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SR-74 ORTEGA HIGHWAY ROADWAY PAVEMENT REHABILITATION

Beginning Mid June 2012

Irvine—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin a \$4.9 million roadway pavement rehabilitation project on the eastbound and westbound lanes of SR-74 from Interstate 5 on the west to just west of Reata Street and .37 miles east of La Pata to the San Juan Canyon Bridge.

This construction contract involves cold planning damaged AC pavement and replacement by overlaying rubberized hot mix asphalt. This contract will include replacement of pavement striping and markers, adjustment of water valve boxes, monument covers, resetting manholes to grade and replacing inductive loop detectors. The lower section will upgrade curb cutouts to ADA standards. The upper section will have additional metal beam guardrail installed.

Estimated first working day will be June 18th 2012 and the project is scheduled for 90 working days.

Night work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. (No full closures, minimum of 1 lane open with flagmen directing traffic).

Some grinding work will be necessary in this process, and areas along SR-74 may experience some noise. Upon completion of the project, motorists will enjoy a smoother roadway. Every effort will be made to minimize the impacts of construction to residents and businesses.

The project contractor is All American Asphalt of Corona California.

As always, to ensure the safety of workers and the traveling public, in a construction zone, please remember to **“slow for the cone zone”, “move over”**, be alert, and proceed with caution.
