State Route 38 (SR-38) Paving Project

A project to rehabilitate the pavement on State Route 38 (SR-38) in the San Bernardino Mountains from Valley of the Falls Drive in Angelus Oaks to north of the junction with SR 18 in Big Bear City began on Tuesday, May 20 and is scheduled to end by Friday, October 10. Work hours are Monday through Saturday from 8:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m. The project will grind the existing roadway and then overlay Rubberized Hot Mix Asphalt Concrete (RHMA), install guardrail and a center line rumble strip.

Although the overall pavement condition is good, the road surface is showing signs of deterioration. By replacing the surface with RHMA, further deterioration can be prevented, the life of the pavement will be extended, and the roadway will provide a smoother ride. The additional guard rail and the center line rumble strip will enhance safety for all motorists.

The project will require lane closures and a pilot car will be used to direct traffic. Traffic may not be stopped in one direction for periods of not more than fifteen minutes except in emergencies. Expect delays and please plan your commute accordingly.
