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Interstate 10 Pavement Project Begins in Palm Springs/Rancho Mirage

Riverside County – Construction will begin Sunday night, June 21 to repair pavement, overlay new asphalt and apply fog seal to the shoulders on 20 miles of Interstate 10 (I-10) in Riverside County. The project extends from Thousand Palms to State Route 111 in Palm Springs.

Paving will begin in the westbound lanes starting at Monterey Avenue. Crews will be moving westbound and expect to pave about five miles each night. Lanes will be closed as needed during the dates and times shown below.

Please follow all advisory signs and **SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE**. The California Highway Patrol will be enforcing reduced speed limits in the construction zone. Construction is expected to last about 70 working days. This “Alert” will be updated each week.
