STATE ROUTE 74 PAVEMENT PRESERVATION PROJECT NEAR PERRIS

RIVERSIDE – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is continuing the pavement preservation project on State Route 74 (SR 74) through the communities of Romoland and Homeland. The contractor is applying a slurry seal to approximately five miles of SR 74 in both directions from Interstate 215 (I-215) to Guthridge Lane.

The work hours are Monday through Friday from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. with one lane closed in each direction. One lane in each direction will remain open on the four lane highway during work hours. The following is the work schedule for the week of June 20:

- Monday, 6/20 Outside lanes from E. Kirby Street to W. Alessandro Street
- Tuesday, 6/21 Inside lanes from E. Kirby Street to W. Alessandro
- Wednesday, 6/22 Outside lanes from Warren Road to Dartmouth Street
- Thursday, 6/23 Inside lanes from Warren Road to Dartmouth Street

The project is expected to be completed in fall 2016, weather permitting. Motorists are advised to add time to their commute to allow for minimal delays or use alternate routes to avoid the work.
