## STATE ROUTE 38 STILL IN EFFECT FOR LAKE FIRE

**SAN BERNARDINO** – Caltrans is informing motorists that the closure on State Route 38 (SR 38) between Angelus Oaks and Lake Williams will continue to remain in effect until further notice. SR 38 closed on Thursday, June 18<sup>th</sup> at approximately 3:00 a.m. due to the Lake Fire burning in the San Bernardino National Forest. The Lake fire began June 17 at approximately 4:00 p.m.

The latest fire update is that the Lake Fire has burned more than 17,000+ acres and is 21% contained. Updated information will be released later today by the US Forest Service and San Bernardino County Fire Department.

Motorists are advised to use State Route 330 and State Route 18 as alternate routes to Big Bear and communities above Lake Williams. Motorists will only be permitted uphill on SR 38 to Angelus Oaks.

If SR 38 opens over the weekend the information will be released by the US Forest Service, San Bernardino County Fire, and Caltrans will announce it on our Twitter account at <https://twitter.com/Caltrans8>.

This commuter alert will only be updated and emailed during business hours, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Again, after-hour updates and information may be obtained on our Twitter account.
