## INTERSTATE 10 DESERT CENTER PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

**RIVERSIDE** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on the \$95 million Interstate 10 (I-10) Pavement Rehabilitation Project. The project will rehabilitate 124 lane miles of pavement in both directions of I-10 between Cactus City and State Route 177 junction.

Pavement work will begin on Monday, June 27, 2016 between Cactus City Rest Area and Chiriaco Summit. The eastbound I-10 will be down to **ONE** lane Monday through Thursday.

The Cactus City Compressor Station and Frontage Road on/off ramps will be closed Tuesday, June 28 between 6:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Box Canyon Road and Cottonwood Springs Road on/off-ramps will be closed Wednesday, June 29 between 6:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
