Interstate 10 Pavement Rehabilitation Project

Update #64

Riverside County – Construction of the Interstate 10 Pavement Rehabilitation Project continues next week. Work will include paving, striping and bridge demolition. Ramps and lanes will be closed as needed within the dates and times shown below. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Ramp closures will be alternated as work is completed.
