PAVING YOUR WAY ON STATE ROUTE 18

San Bernardino County – Caltrans will begin another paving project to restore deteriorated pavement on State Route 18 (SR-18) from Keller Peak Road (near Arrowbear) to Snow Valley Ski Resort. The project will begin on Monday, July 9, and is expected to be complete by the end of July 2007.

The work will take place Monday through Thursday from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and on Fridays from 7:00 a.m. to noon. Some traffic control with flagging will be necessary in the two lane sections. The four-lane sections will not require flagging. Delays are expected to be minor but add some extra time to your trip just in case.

California Highway Patrol (CHP) will be on scene to assist with traffic control. Please have patience and remember that it is easier to stop driving uphill and harder to stop when driving downhill. At 55 miles per hour, you are traveling over 80 feet per second. A lot can happen in one second, so give yourself plenty of room to stop before the traffic control area.

Follow all directions given by the CHP and construction workers (flaggers) for your safety and theirs.
