## ROAD WORK TO BEGIN ON STATE ROUTE 189

**San Bernardino** – Caltrans will begin construction on a \$253,000 project on State Route 189 between Sierra Vista Drive and Grass Valley Road. The project is set to begin June 30<sup>th</sup> and will be complete by the end of July. The project will improve drainage at two locations. One location will provide improved shoulders with cross gutters to focus the flow of water from the highway. The second location will increase the size of the drainpipe to increase the capacity of the drain. In addition, that location will have some shoulder grading to help channel the water towards the drainage system. Concrete pavement will be placed above the new drainpipe to protect it from vehicle wear.

The work hours are Monday through Thursday from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Fridays from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Minor delays are expected during the operations that require lane restrictions. Flaggers will be present for traffic control. Please be aware of Flaggers and drive safely through the construction zone. Traffic impacts are expected to be minimal. **There will be no lane restrictions between July 3<sup>rd</sup> and July 7<sup>th</sup>. Work will resume on Tuesday, July 8<sup>th</sup>.**
