## Nighttime Freeway Closures Planned for Bridge Construction at Rancho Road

**Hesperia, CA** – Crews will require nighttime closures Interstate 15 between Oak Hills Road and US 395 beginning Tuesday, July 1<sup>st</sup> and continuing through Thursday morning (see Closure Detail). Lane closures will begin at 9pm with full closures starting on the northbound side at midnight and the southbound direction at 11pm. Northbound closures will be lifted at 6am the following morning and southbound will be lifted at 5am to meet the demand of morning commute traffic. The newly constructed on and off ramps at Rancho Road will be used as detours during the full directional closures. Motorists are encouraged to slow down when traveling through the construction area and be mindful of construction equipment and personnel.

The closures are necessary so crews can safely construct the support structure needed for constructing the new Rancho Road bridge over Interstate 15. This activity marks a major milestone in the bridge construction effort following the May 5<sup>th</sup> fire that consumed much of the bridge falsework that had been previously erected.
