State Route 62 (SR-62) Paving and Shoulder Widening Project

A project to rehabilitate the pavement on State Route 62 (SR-62) from the 10/62 separation to Indian Avenue will continue next week. The project involves repaving of the existing roadway, widening the existing inside shoulder from two to five feet, upgrading the metal beam guardrail and replacement of an existing dike.

There will be closures of the #1 and #2 lanes in each direction of SR-62 from Indian Canyon Avenue to the I-10 connector next week, in order to perform concrete tests, as well as restripe the roadway. The closures will take place Monday through Friday from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Please be advised that there is still limits for oversized loads, as there are 11 feet shoulders in some locations, as well as the bridge near Paradise Avenue has a horizontal clearance of 26 feet. Additionally, left turns will not be permitted onto Dillon Road, from either direction, due to the presence of k-rail. The project is expected to be complete by early summer 2014.
