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WHAT: PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

WHEN: BEGAN MARCH 2012

WHERE: INTERSTATE 15 IN FONTANA AND RANCHO CUCAMONGA

Fontana/Rancho Cucamonga – Construction began in March 2012 to provide pavement rehabilitation on a 9-mile stretch of Interstate 15 (I-15) from 7th Street in the City of Rancho Cucamonga to Sierra Avenue in the City of Fontana. The \$82 million project is being done by Griffith/Coffman Joint Venture, Inc.

Motorists are advised to expect up to three lanes closed on north and southbound I-15 between the project limits from Sunday evenings to Saturday mornings. The work will be conducted at night from 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. on southbound I-15 and 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. on northbound I-15. The lane closures could take place simultaneously or alternately in either direction.

The project will rehabilitate portions of the No. 3 and No. 4 lanes, add a new lane next to the median, and rehabilitate the outside shoulder. The work is expected to improve the ride quality, extend pavement life, and improve facility operation and safety. The project is expected to be completed in late 2013.

Motorists are advised to plan ahead and add time to your commute during the work hours to avoid delays.
