WHAT: SLAB REPLACEMENT PROJECT

WHEN: LATE MAY TO FALL 2012

WHERE: INTERSTATE 15 FROM CAJON PASS TO FONTANA AND
INTERSTATE 10 FROM MONCLAIR TO ONTARIO

San Bernardino County – Construction began in late May 2012 to replace slabs on Interstate 15 from Oak Hill in Cajon Pass to Sierra Avenue in Fontana and will begin on Interstate 10 from Montclair to Ontario. The \$2.9 million project is expected to be complete by fall 2012.

Interstate 15:

Motorists are advised to expect up to three lanes closed on north and southbound I-15 between the above project limits from Sunday evenings to Saturday mornings. The work will be conducted at night from 8:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. on northbound I-15 and 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. on southbound I-15. The lane closures could take place simultaneously or alternately in either direction.

Interstate 10:

Schedule information for the I-10 work will follow once available.

Motorists are advised that ramp closures will also be necessary during this work to protect the work zone. Signage will be placed at the ramps in advance to notify the public of the impending ramp closure.

Please plan ahead and add time to your commute during the work hours to avoid delays.
