## **PREPARING TO POUR THE SECOND HALF OF BOX SPRINGS BRIDGE REQUIRES FULL FREEWAY CLOSURE**

**RIVERSIDE** – The California Department of Transportation, (Caltrans) announces closures of both northbound and southbound 215 (westbound and eastbound 60). The closures will take place between July 6<sup>th</sup> and July 15<sup>th</sup>. During the closures, the contractor will be erecting the falsework that will be the temporary framing for the constructing of the bridge deck.

**Detours:** NB motorists will be taken off at the Box Springs off ramp and back onto the freeway utilizing the Box Springs on ramp. SB motorists will be taken off at the Box Springs off ramp, left on Sycamore Canyon and left onto the future I-215 on ramp.
