US-95 Paving Project to Begin

United States 95 - San Bernardino County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces the beginning of a three-mile pavement rehabilitation project 15 miles south of Needles, CA on US-95. The contract was awarded to Granite Construction in May 2008. This \$805,000 project is scheduled to begin July 08, 2008 with closures for digouts and paving.

On Monday, July 21, the contractor will come back in and place permanent striping and pavement markers.

In order to keep you moving and on time we have provided the work schedule below.
