Full closure of Etiwanda Avenue and Van Buren Boulevard intersection in Mira Loma

The Etiwanda Avenue and Van Buren Boulevard intersection in Mira Loma will be closed to traffic from July 9 to July 19.

Detours will be clearly marked. Detour routes will vary based on the driver's travel direction. Detailed information and a map are available online at http://www.rctlma.org/trans/documents/Etiwanda_Van_Buren%20Closure.pdf.

Commercial trucks will not be allowed on portions of the detour routes. Trucks are advised to use Wineville Road to get around the closure.

The intersection will be reconstructed and repaved during the nine-day closure. Starting July 20, additional work will continue north on Etiwanda Avenue up to Philadelphia Street. The second phase will be completed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. in about 30 days. One lane will be available for each travel direction on Etiwanda during the evening construction.

The Riverside County Transportation Department awarded the \$3.48 million contract to Corona-based All American Asphalt.
