I-10 PAVING CONTINUES

BLYTHE – Caltrans continues a paving operation in eastern Riverside County on I-10 between Chiriaco Summit and Blythe.

The contractor will complete paving of the open graded lanes today. They are currently paving at Ford Dry Lake Road on the eastbound side. Thursday & Friday, July 10th and 11th they will have a moving lane closure to fog seal the shoulders. Beginning July 14-18 & July 21-25, the Contractor will again have a moving lane closure to complete the 120 lane miles of striping on this project. Crews are working 5 AM to 4 PM, Monday through Friday. Anticipate project completion by July 31, 2008.

The CHP Office in Blythe will provide COZEEP units to assist during the rolling closures. Give yourself extra commute time and have an alternate route selected before you travel.
