PAVING BEGINS ON STATE ROUTE 111 IN PALM SPRINGS

RIVERSIDE COUNTY – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin paving operations next week on State Route 111 between Sunrise Way and Roberto Miguel in Palm Springs. Maintenance crews will surface grind a one-mile segment of northbound SR-111 Monday and Tuesday, July 14th and 15th and will pave on Wednesday, July 16th between 5 AM and 3 PM each day.

Safety is a high priority for Caltrans, not only for the field crews, but for the motorists who travel through this area as well. In line with safety, the outside lane (#2 lane) will be closed on the northbound side through the construction zone.

Be prepared to merge early. Please be courteous and create a space for merging vehicles so everyone can get from Point A to Point B. Thank you for your continued patience and support during this improvement project. Caltrans asks that motorists be aware of the construction area and always make a point to ***SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE***. The life you save may be your own!
