WHAT: BRIDGE HIT BY BIG RIG

WHEN: WEDNESDAY, JULY 10, 2013

WHERE: SOUTHBOUND INTERSTATE 215 AT PERRIS BLVD.

Caltrans District 8 is pleased to announce that the false work structure that was hit with a high load on southbound Interstate 215 (I-215) at Perris Blvd. in Perris yesterday morning, reopened yesterday afternoon at approximately 5:30 p.m.

An additional closure of southbound I-215 at the same location will be necessary to complete repairs to the false work. The closure will begin tonight, Wednesday, July 10, from 10:00 p.m. until tomorrow morning, Thursday, July 11, at 5:00 a.m.

Motorists are advised to adjust their travel time to avoid the closure, however a detour is in place at Nuevo Road.
