FOUR-HOUR ON AND OFF-RAMP CLOSURES ON NORTHBOUND INTERSTATE 215 (I-215) IN PERRIS ON MONDAY, JULY 18

SAN BERNARDINO – The California State Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is currently working on a pavement preservation project on State Route 74 (SR 74) through the communities of Romoland and Homeland. The contractor is applying slurry seal to approximately five miles of SR-74 in both directions from I-215 to Guthridge Lane.

In order to allow enough time for adequate application and drying of the slurry seal, the northbound on and off-ramps of I-215 at the lower SR-74 interchange in Perris will be closed from 10:00 A.M. - 2:00 P.M. on Monday, July 18. Detours will be available, however motorists are advised to add time to their commute to allow for delays.
