UPDATE

PAVEMENT RESURFACING PROMPTS LANE/RAMP CLOSURES 25 MILES OF STATE ROUTE 58 FROM MOJAVE TO BORON

WHO: The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with Maverick Asphalt and Construction Company is currently performing a pavement rehabilitation project.

WHAT: The approximately \$3-million project will rehabilitate the pavement on a 25-mile segment of State Route 58 from 1.1 mile east of the Business Route 58 overcrossing near Mojave to the San Bernardino County Line near Boron.

LANE/RAMP CLOSURES WEEK OF JULY 13 - 17: Paving operations requiring lane closures will occur on eastbound State Route 58 approximately one mile east of Exit 172 (Business Route 58) and to Exit 186 (Edwards AFB) Additionally, eastbound State Route 58 Exit 186 (Edwards AFB) off-ramp is anticipated to close Thursday, July 16 between the hours of 6 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Work hours: Mondays through Thursdays from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Fridays from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m. The project is expected to be complete in late summer.

DETOUR: During the eastbound State Route 58 Exit 186 off-ramp closure, motorists can use the Exit 188 off-ramp and return to westbound State Route 58 to the westbound Edwards Exit 186 off-ramp.

Caltrans thanks motorists for their patience as we rehabilitate this segment of SR-58. Motorists are reminded to allow additional travel time and drive with extra care through construction zones. Please **“Slow for the Cone Zone.”**
