WHAT: STORM DAMAGE/DIRECTORS ORDER
WHEN: ROAD CLOSED JULY 14, 2012
WHERE: STATE ROUTE 62 FROM GODWIN AVENUE TO SR 177

Flash flooding washed out sections of SR 62 early Saturday morning between Godwin Avenue and SR 177 (north of Twentynine Palms). As a result the road is closed and an emergency Directors Order is in place. The repair work began over the weekend.

Caltrans hopes to have enough repairs made to reopen SR 62 to motorists by Tuesday (July 17) evening, however traffic control will be necessary for a couple of days while the repairs are being completed.

The work is expected to last for approximately a week.

Considerable storm damage to shoulders on SR 177 and Route 95 also occurred so be advised that road workers will be making repairs throughout the next few weeks. **Please slow down and drive safely through these work zones.**

Motorists and trucks are advised to use alternate routes such as I-40, I-10, or Route 95 to avoid delays.
