Subject: **Traffic Advisory for the Banning Civic Center Area**

Dear Resident or Business Owner:

The purpose of this traffic advisory is to notify you of upcoming road closures in the Banning Civic Center area.

Construction of the new Banning Police Station, at the northwest corner of Ramsey Street and Alessandro Road, will commence on July 16th, 2008 and will require the closures of two City streets. Alessandro Road, from Ramsey Street to Hays Street will be closed during construction in order to maximize public safety, and Hays Street, from Alessandro Road to Murray Street will be closed indefinitely. A Construction Site Plan has been enclosed for your information.

Additionally, contractors will construct parking lot improvements and install landscaping along the west side of City Hall beginning August 1, 2008. This process will require the intermittent lane closures of Ramsey Street, near the San Gorgonio Avenue intersection; San Gorgonio Avenue, from Ramsey Street to Hays Street; and Hays Street, from San Gorgonio Avenue to Murray Street.

We appreciate your patience during the construction of these important public improvements and will reopen these streets as soon as construction has been completed. If you have any questions or concerns, please call the Engineering Division at (951) 922-3130.
