SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) & San Bernardino Associated Governments (SANBAG) are continuing work on the I-215 Widening Project. This week crews are working on overhead sign structures.

We remind motorists that the legal speed limit has been reduced to 55 mph through the construction area. Please slow down and keep a safe driving distance from the vehicle in front of you.

To Eastbound SR-210 – Exit Baseline St., right turn to H St., turn left to Highland Ave. turn left and enter SR-259 to eastbound SR-210.
Thursday, July 19 10 p.m. – 4 a.m.	Southbound I-215 University Parkway on-ramp	Take Northbound I-215, exit Palm Ave. and re-enter southbound I-215 at Palm Ave.
Friday, July 20 10 p.m. – 4 a.m.	Eastbound SR-210 to Northbound I-215 connector	Continue eastbound on SR-210 and exit H St. turn left and re-enter westbound SR-210 to northbound I-215
