**WHAT:** “MOUNTAIN FIRE” INCIDENT UPDATE

**WHERE:** STATE ROUTE (SR) 243/74

A wildfire began Monday, July 15, near State Route 243 and 74 in Riverside County. The fire has grown to over 25,000 acres and is approximately 15% contained.

**SR 74 reopened yesterday evening, July 18, with no restrictions.**

**SR 243 remains closed to Idyllwild residents from Mountain Center to Lake Fulmor Vista Point. Residents who need to access above Lake Fulmor up to the Nature Center will be permitted with proof of residency at the Lake Fulmor closure only.**
