SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) & San Bernardino Associated Governments (SANBAG) are continuing work on the I-215 Widening Project. This week crews are working on various bridges, walls, ramps, connectors, and the median throughout the project area, weather permitting.

We remind motorists that the legal speed limit has been reduced to 55 mph through the construction area. Please slow down and keep a safe driving distance from the vehicle in front of you.

Sunday, July 22 – Friday, July 27 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.	Northwest I-215 to westbound SR-210 connector closure	Exit Baseline St., turn right, turn right on H St. to 30 th St., left on 30 th St. to H St., left on H St. to re-enter westbound SR-210
Sunday, July 22 – Friday, July 27 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.	NB and SB I-215 alternating lane closures between Rialto Ave. and University Pkwy.	No detour necessary as at least one lane will remain open when full freeway closures are not taking place.
Monday , July 23 to Friday, Friday, July 27 8 p.m. to 4 a.m.	SB SR-259 Connector Closure	Exit Highland Ave. and turn left, turn right on H Street, and access I-215 using 5 th St. on-ramp. Or Exit Highland Ave., turn right, go to Mt. Vernon and turn left, go to 5 th St. turn left to re-enter SB I-215
