INTERSTATE 10 DESERT CENTER PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

RIVERSIDE – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on the \$95 million Interstate 10 (I-10) Pavement Rehabilitation Project. The project will rehabilitate 124 lane miles of pavement in both directions of I-10 between Cactus City and State Route 177 junction (SR-177).

Pavement work will be westbound between SR-177 Junction/Desert Center Rice Road and Chiriaco Summit. Westbound I-10 will be down to **ONE** lane Monday through Friday between 9:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.

The westbound Eagle Mountain Road, Red Cloud Mine Road, Hayfield Road, and Chiriaco Summit Road on/off ramps will be closed on various days between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

The details of work for **July 25 to July 29, 2016** are detailed below:
