**WHAT: PAVEMENT WORK**

**WHEN: WEEK OF JULY 23, 2012**

**WHERE: STATE ROUTE 18 BETWEEN UPPER WATERMAN CANYON & SR 138**

Caltrans Maintenance crews are performing pavement repair with a method known as “tight blade” on State Route 18 (SR 18) in various locations between Upper Waterman Canyon and State Route 138 (SR 138).

One of two lanes will close intermittently in either direction of SR 18 from Monday, July 23, to Friday, July 27 between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

The work is preparation for a seal coat project that will take place in August 2012. This method of pavement repair is longer lasting than typical pothole repair and more effective in areas of extreme temperatures, such as the San Bernardino Mountains.

***Please be aware that road workers are on the highway...slow down and move over.***
