FULL CLOSURES FOR THE 60/216 FREEWAYS AT BOX SPRINGS

RIVERSIDE – The California Department of Transportation, (Caltrans) will conduct full closures on the 60/215 freeways. The closures will begin on Thursday, July 26th through Friday, August 3rd. During the closures the contractor will be placing temporary framing for the second half of the new Box Springs Bridge Overcrossing.

DETOURS

WB 60 to SB 215: Exit at Day St., south on Day St., west on Eucalyptus Ave., and proceed to SB 215. Optional - continue on WB 60, exit at Central Ave. off ramp, west on Central, and on to SB 215.

NB 215 to EB 60: Exit at Eucalyptus Ave., east on Eucalyptus Ave., north on Day St., and proceed to EB 60. Optional - continue on NB 215, exit at Central Ave. off ramp, west on Central, and on to SB 215 or EB 60.

NB 215 to NB 215: Exit at Eucalyptus Ave., east on Eucalyptus Ave., north on Day St., and proceed to WB 60 and on to NB 215. Optional - continue on NB 215 to EB 60, exit at Day St. off ramp, north on Day St, proceed to EB 60 and on to NB 215.
