Interstate 10 Pavement Project in Palm Springs/Rancho Mirage

Riverside County – Construction continues tonight to repair pavement and overlay new asphalt on 20 miles of Interstate 10 (I-10) in Riverside County. The project extends from Thousand Palms to State Route 111 in Palm Springs.

Tonight, crews will be working in the westbound lanes. Lanes will be closed as needed during the dates and times shown below. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time.

Please follow all advisory signs and **SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE**. The California Highway Patrol will be enforcing reduced speed limits in the construction zone. Paving work is expected to end around August 13. After paving is complete, final striping and fog seal will be applied and electronic traffic detector loops will be replaced.
