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STATE ROUTE 60 RESTRIPIING PROJECT BEGINS IN RIVERSIDE

Riverside - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) begins construction Sunday night to restripe and replace pavement markers on State Route 60 (SR-60) in Riverside County. The project starts about one-half mile west of the Valley Way Undercrossing and ends east of Main Street. Chrisp Company was awarded the project with a bid of \$111,000.

Closures will occur during the times and locations shown below. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time.
