STATE ROUTE 79 UPDATE – SIGNAL TURN-ON

On August 5, the new traffic signals will be turned on at Scott Road and SR-79. After the signal turn-on there will be two lanes in each direction, with a dedicated left and right turn lane.

The County recommends that commuters avoid the Scott Road intersection the afternoon of August 5th during the signal turn-on operation. Flaggers will be utilized during peak traffic periods to minimize back-up traffic through the intersection until the signal is operational. The signal will be fully operational by August 6.

There are two remaining signals that will be activated as follows:

- 1) The intersection of Newport Road and SR-79, expect operation by the end of August.
- 2) The intersection of Keller Road and SR-79, expect operation by late September.

After all signals are operational, punch list work will continue for the next couple of months or until the work is completed.
